


Recently they lived in Cypress, the island near Israel, where Javed had a restaurant featuring pizza, burgers, and fast food. Javed is not only a fine cook, he fixes appliances, and has preached the Word in Pakistan where his parents, Noshi's parents, and some of his siblings live. Their parents are in hiding because Christians are persecuted in Pakistan. Javed, Asif, and Shahzad took their faith and energies to Pakistan to minister to people in several towns. Using on line contributions, they cared for the poor and spread the Word. It was his sister in Cypress who had a friend in Niagara Falls, NY, that encouraged the permanent move to the US.

Javed is a traveler who's been to Los Angeles, Las Vegas, and Salt Lake City in the US and to Germany and France where the people are very friendly, in Europe. Javed speaks 4 languages fluently and two others marginally.

Noshi and Javed like the freedom to worship, the safety in our city, and the schools of Niagara Falls. Leaving a big home in Pakistan where the whole family lived together was difficult. Now this smaller group (14) live together on Walnut Avenue. Soccer is Robinyo's favorite sport at La Salle Junior High School and Ozena at G J Mann Elementary likes basketball and wants to learn to play the piano. Languages spoken are English, Turkish, Punjabi, and Esperanto, and Farsi.

Their birthdays are December 7-Ozena, December 10-Robinyo, March 27-Noshi, and September 4-Javed. Imagine travelling 4,000-5,000 miles to move from your home and we hope to make it a warm welcome here at First Baptist to them all.



Shelter Director Anna Coleman uses the CWS Blankets to spread the word about WestCare. She distributes CWS Blankets and Hygiene Kits to homeless individuals living under bridges and in tunnels. Anna adds a note inside of each blanket letting the individuals know that they can go to the shelter to bathe, eat a hot meal and wash their clothes.





Exodus — exit from Egypt. God's chosen children are led by Moses to the promised land of Canaan.


Leviticus — Levitical priesthood is initiated. God's chosen priests to teach God's law on how to live.
